## GREEN BELT Plan Making Support



The 2024 National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) contains important implications for Local Planning Authorities where **Green Belt** is situated which **require careful consideration through the plan-making process**. There is now a clearer emphasis on Green Belt boundaries being reviewed through the preparation or updating of local plans, particularly to meet development needs.

The 2024 NPPF also introduced **grey belt**, which comprises previously developed land and/or any other land that does not contribute strongly to specific Green Belt purposes. Within grey belt, development is not regarded as inappropriate providing it does not undermine the purposes of the remaining Green Belt.
